healthy lunch from 11:30-12:00 and then they will join our 21st Century Staff for an afternoon filled with sun and fun! Transportation to and from the program will <u>not</u> be provided. Parents will have to transport their children to the program for 11:30am and pick up from the program by 4:30pm.

Thanks to a partnership with the Franklin County Children's Task Force and the MSAD #58, there will be **NO FEE** for this summer program. This application is for children who are currently entering Kindergarten through those entering 8th grade in Strong Elementary, Phillips Elementary, and Kingfield Elementary schools.

What do we do?

- **Dates** Summer programming runs Monday through Friday from <u>July 2nd through August 3rd</u> starting at 11:30am until 4:30pm. Friday's will be "Field Trip Friday's" as we will be exploring the area and all it has to offer! We will not have programming on the 4th of July.
- Academic enrichment Don't let the summer months escape you! Research shows that over summer break, the average student loses half a year of reading grade level. Not in our program! Students will be challenged with fun and exciting academic enrichment from skilled professionals, all-the-while having a blast!
- **S.T.E.M.** Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math. Science is fun! Your child will have the opportunity to engage in hands-on learning in a way that's designed to make them want to come back day after day. Lots of excitement!!!
- **Kid Friendly Fun!** Your child will be swimming 2 days a week in a supervised and safe environment by certified lifeguards (but they will need their suit every day)! Your child will participate in outdoor sports, team-building activities, nature walks, arts and crafts projects, science experiments, and the list goes on...
